Food and Feed Ingredients Webinar Series



The events discussed global trends, technical applications in the industry, and the uniqueness of these U.S. products. Therefore, it was an opportunity for professionals to deepen their knowledge of the applications and strategies adopted by the American industry in the use of ingredients for human and animal nutrition.


The webinars included a technical speaker from each Cooperators for the main presentation. Each event lasted approximately 60 minutes and was divided into four panels: USDA introduction (5 min), Cooperator introduction (5 min), main presentation (30 min), Q&A session (20 min). In addition, the webinars had simultaneous translation throughout the event as well as Portuguese subtitles during the main presentation. These webinars attracted primarily researchers & developers, scientific researchers, importers, quality specialists, and sales representatives. The companies were mainly food industries, research institutions, food importers and distributors, consulting companies, and others.

Poll questions were made available during and after the webinars to gather market information and evaluate the events. The Cooperators assisted the Agricultural Trade Office (ATO) in developing technical polls and evaluation questionnaires. The use of polls to extract information from the participants was a powerful tool to understand the market better and find opportunities. All the information collected in the event was shared with the Cooperators for analysis and market information.

Evaluation and Participation

The events had excellent evaluations from the participants. Approximately 90 percent of the audience said that the events were "Excellent" or "Very Good." In terms of attendance, each webinar counted with an average audience of 100 participants and more than 250 registrations.
